

AREA REPRESENTATIVES

The duties of Area Representatives shall be to:

- (1).. Organize at least four (4) area meetings per year
- (2).. attend at least two (2) Board meetings per year
- (3). provide a written report to the Member at Large detailing goals for the year including the number of new members 5% growth represents and a plan for obtaining that goal
- (4). develop and maintain on a monthly basis, contact information, including email list serve, for all Association members in representative's area
- (5). contact area Association members monthly – to provide friendly reminder of renewal that month, if indicated – to welcome new members and establish connection with members and activities – to encourage reconnection and membership renewal for persons whose membership is lapsed – to inform of area activities and encourage participation

Area Representatives qualify for mileage reimbursement to and from two (2) Board Meetings, and upon full completion of a year of service, the Area Representative will receive a 25% off coupon to be used on the Missouri Association for Play Therapy workshop of their choice to expire one year from the end date of the completed year of service. Also you will receive Annual State Conference free as long as the requirements have been met

To Become an Area Representative for Missouri Association for Play Therapy

In order to become an area representative for MAPT candidates need to present a letter of intent, including experience, goals and why they want to become an area representative. Also candidates will need two letters of recommendations that support their abilities to lead and represent MAPT. This information should be submitted to the Member at Large who will submit it to the board for a vote. Some areas may require more than one area representative.
